Guidelines and Criteria

Eligibility

The Adani Australia Community Partnerships Program applications must fit within the parameters of our core community focus areas to be eligible for funding.

- Education
- Health
- Sustainable Communities
- Environmental Stewardship
- Social Welfare

Conditions

- If you are successful, you must provide a post-funding report outlining your outcomes. Funds must be used in the way they were applied for or you must supply a variation.
- If the program or event is cancelled, you must notify Adani Australia and come to agreement on alternative plan to expend the funds.
- Sponsorship or donation requests of up to \$10,000 are required to be submitted via the Community Partnerships Program application form by 5:00pm on the closing date of that round.

When you apply for the Adani Australia Community Partnerships Program you need to:

- Deliver a project located within one of the Local Government Areas listed within this document.
- Be a not for profit group or community project.
- Involve the broader community where possible.
- Develop community capacity and capability.
- Align with the focus areas listed within this document.

We will not provide community investment support to organisations that are:

- For profit, without clear community connection.
- Discriminating on the basis of race, gender, ethnicity or lifestyle.
- Based around religious or political activities.
- Supporting an individual.
- Involved in advocacy or lobbying.
- Projects or programs that would ordinarily be fully funded by any level of Government.
