Adani Renewables Australia will switch on its first solar farm at Rugby Run near Moranbah in late 2018.




Adani Australia owns and operates Abbot Point Terminal which has been exporting Queensland coal responsibly for 30 years.

A 200km narrow gauge rail line will be built, connecting to the existing rail network, to transfer coal from the Carmichael Mine to Abbot Point Terminal earning billions of dollars in export revenue for Queensland.
